## Woodlands Library Cooperative Continuing Education Policy

- 1. The Continuing Education Committee will have direct responsibility for planning and organizing workshops.
- 2. Any other Woodlands committee may also choose to organize and sponsor a workshop, but the Continuing Education Committee must be informed of such plans in order to avoid scheduling conflicts. A calendar of workshop dates will be kept by the cooperative office.
- 3. The Continuing Education Committee shall assist other committees in the development of workshops, when such help is requested.
- 4. The Continuing Education Committee shall serve as a clearing-house for information on all workshops sponsored by the cooperative, and shall maintain a calendar of workshop dates as noted above.
- 5. Workshops should be planned on a yearly basis, and developed so as to avoid duplication with other agencies outside the cooperative.
- 6. Workshops should be planned, whenever possible, as self-contained, one-day training events. This is intended to minimize costs and to encourage greater attendance.
- 7. Expenses at attendees at co-op sponsored workshops should be limited to their meals, material costs, and mileage. There will be no additional "workshop fee" for attendees from Woodlands member libraries and Associate Member organizations.
- 8. The cooperative will reimburse presenters for mileage and expenses incurred in presenting a workshop for the Woodlands Library Cooperative. Honorariums will not be paid to speakers who are employed by member or associate member libraries.
- 9. The co-op will meet other expenses of the workshop, such as the cost of printing and publicity, and other items.
- 10. Workshops are open to all staff members of member libraries. Non-affiliated libraries and members of other cooperatives may attend as space permits. A registration fee will be charged to non-member libraries.
- 11. Workshops will be balanced in subject matter so that both professional and nonprofessional staff members are provided opportunities for training.
- 12. The Continuing Education Committee will seek suggestions for workshops as widely as possible. Suggestions from member libraries are welcome.
